- Applicants must be full-time students in a western New York high school and have a minimum overall 3.0 or 80% GPA.
- Preference for Section scholarship awards is given to students who are accepted in an instrumentation, systems, or automation discipline or equivalent at an accredited college located with Western New York.
- Application must be postmarked no later than 31 March 2016. However, the application must be received at ISA-Niagara Frontier Section Scholarship Committee no later than 8 April 2016 to be eligible.
- Submit one original with 2 copies of all application documentation. Staple each set individually (Do not paperclip).
