- Preference for Section scholarship awards is given to students who are accepted in an instrumentation, systems, or automation discipline or equivalent at an accredited college located with Western New York.
- Application must be postmarked no later than 30 April 2020. However, the application must be received at ISA-Niagara Frontier Section Scholarship Committee no later than 10 May 2020 to be eligible.
- **Submit one original with 2 copies of all application documentation.** Staple each set individually (Do not paperclip).
